





COVID-19 Risk Assessment Update – 28th February 2022

Measures already in place that all staff and children should be adhering to:

- Good hand hygiene
- Good ventilation in rooms
- Children come to school in PE kits

Measures from 28th February 2022:

- Public health advice for People with COVID-19 and their contacts changed from 24 February. Contacts are no longer required to self-isolate or advised to take daily tests, and contact tracing has ended
- From 21 February, staff and pupils in mainstream secondary schools will not be expected to continue taking part in regular asymptomatic testing
- Assemblies in Southwood will continue by Zoom. Downs Barn and Germander Park will be in person, with each year group being socially distanced from each other
- Children with the main Covid-19 symptoms should not attend school. Remote learning will be provided if children are isolating, but well enough to complete work
- If staff have Covid-19 symptoms, they will be asked to stay at home for 5 days and if two negative tests have been
- No whole school team meetings will take place, unless necessary
- Children will be separated in schools for Breakfast Club and ACERs
- Visits will take place, but with enhanced hand hygiene and wash-do-wash mantra
- Regulation Stations should not be used
- Parents and Carers can be invited into school for assemblies/presentations

Outbreak Management Plan

Should Public Health require the schools to implement more significant measures, the schools would revert back to all measures outlined in the March 2021 Re-opening Models.
