Maths

This half term we will be recognising and comparing numbers within 100. This will involve understanding the place value of a number and being able to explain what a ten and one is. We will also be ordering numbers and comparing the size of different numbers. The children will also be building upon their reasoning skills, being able to explain their mathematical thinking verbally. Please take opportunities to count forwards and backwards with your children at home up to 50.



Science



We will be exploring and comparing the differences between things which are living, dead and have never been alive. We will also identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different animals.

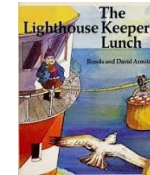
