Literacy	<p>Our topic this half term is Fantasy Lands.</p> <p>Monday – Ask an adult to log on to Tapestry and look for the video called ‘World Book Day’ and listen to Miss Williams read the story Rumble in the Jungle.</p> <p>Tuesday – In the story Rumble in the jungle there are lots of different animals. We are going to draw different animals and write labels of the animals over the next three days. Can you draw a zebra and copy the label next to your drawing?</p> <div data-bbox="662 814 964 1138"></div> <p data-bbox="980 905 1105 953">zebra</p> <p>Wednesday – Can you talk to an adult about the story Rumble in the Jungle? How many of the animals can you remember? 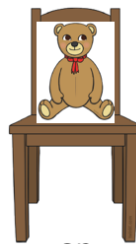
Tuesday – Today I would like you to draw a creature, monster or insect with 10 spots. There are some examples below, but you can draw your creature to look however you like!



Wednesday – For today's Maths activity you will need your favourite teddy or toy! You are going to put your toy in different positions around your house. Can you put it under something, can you put it on something, can you put it next to something? Ask an adult to take photos of you and your object and send them to Miss Williams badgers@germanderpark.com



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






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Thursday – Today you are going to draw an octopus. They have 8 legs! Do you have 8 legs? Carefully count the legs as you draw them. Ask an adult to take a photo and email it to Miss Williams badgers@germanderpark.com



Friday – Today we are going to practice counting to the number nine. Can you tap different parts of your body as you count to the number nine? For example, you could tap your head 9 times. Remember not to tap your body on zero because zero is nothing. Ask an adult to record a video of you counting and send it to Miss Williams badgers@germanderpark.com

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>This week in Maths we are learning all about the numbers to 10.</p> <p>Monday – Listen carefully to the phase two sounds in the video. Can you press pause after each and practice saying it out loud? Do you recognize any of the sounds from your name? Phase 2 Phonic Sound Help with Pronunciation - YouTube</p> <p>Tuesday – Look around the rooms in your house what can you see? Say the words of the objects you see and then what <u>sound</u> they begin with. Play 'my turn, your turn' with an adult and ask them what they can see too. E.g. d – door, t – table, w – window, f - food</p> <p>Wednesday – Carefully draw a picture of a cat, a tap and a peg. Then use the letters (graphemes) below each word to help you write them correctly.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;"> <div style="text-align: center;">   <p>c a t</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">   <p>p t a</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">   <p>p g e</p> </div> </div>

Thursday – Today you are going to practice saying the phonemes (sounds) in each word and then blend them together to read the words. Ask an adult to pause on each word, like in the picture below so you can practice saying the phonemes aloud. For example, s-a-t → sat

Friday – Today we are going to practice saying and writing some of the tricky words we have learnt, remember if you cannot decode a word it might be a tricky word! Here is a video to remind you.
